On July 7th at approximately 11:00 a.m. Criminal Investigators arrested three suspects related to numerous residential burglaries in Glynn County within recent months.

Investigators arrested Roderick Thomas, Javon Newton and William Gilkey at 2106 Parkwood Drive. Thomas fled on foot for approximately three blocks when the taser was utilized to effect his arrest.

Roderick D. Thomas, age 21, of Brunswick was charged with two counts of burglary, three felony theft by receiving stolen property and one misdemeanor theft by receiving stolen property. Thomas also had outstanding warrants for criminal damage to property, battery and cruelty to children.

Javon Newton, age 21 of Brunswick, was charged with two counts of burglary, five counts of felony theft by receiving stolen property and two counts of misdemeanor theft by deception.

William Gilkey, age 21 of Brunswick was charged with two counts of burglary, two felony theft by receiving stolen property and one misdemeanor theft by receiving stolen property. Gilkey also had an outstanding warrant for driving on a suspended license.

The charges stem from burglaries which occurred on Royal Drive, Buford Road, Buckswamp Road, Serenoa Drive, Fancy Bluff Road, Old Jesup Road and Magnolia Avenue. A large amount of stolen property related to these burglaries has been recovered which includes weapons, jewelry and electronic equipment.

More charges against these suspects are anticipated. The investigation continues by Inv. David Moore, 279-2905. Anyone with information on these crimes is urged to contact Inv. Moore.
